On behalf of The World Federation of KSIMC, we would like to express our heartfelt gratitude for your generous contribution of AUD \$345,500 towards the Gaza Reverse Osmosis Desalination Plants project. Your continued support, together with the generosity and trust of your donors, is deeply appreciated. We are honoured to have the Imam Hasan Foundation as a valued partner and longstanding supporter in our efforts to serve some of the world's most vulnerable communities.

Gaza is currently facing one of the most severe humanitarian crises in the world. According to UNICEF, access to safe drinking water has become increasingly scarce, with 9 out of every 10 Gazans unable to reliably access clean water for basic daily needs. The situation on the ground is deeply concerning, and the need for sustainable, long-term solutions has never been greater.

Your donation will directly fund the procurement and installation of two solar-powered Reverse Osmosis units in the north and south of Gaza, in areas identified as experiencing the most acute shortages of safe drinking water. Together, these units will produce 40,000 litres of clean, potable water every single day, reaching approximately 10,000 beneficiaries daily. Each unit will be equipped with its own solar power system, ensuring continuous and sustainable operation.

The impact of your generosity will be felt every day by thousands of families in Gaza who have been deprived of access to something as fundamental as clean drinking water. May Allah accept this contribution and reward you all abundantly for the difference you are making in the lives of those most in need.
